# Introduction to Therapy Dog Skills Session 3-11 AM Saturdays 

 Classes held on 4-23, 4-30, 5-7 \& 5-14

## Prerequisites:

Handlers must be at least 18 years of age.

Dog must be at least 1 year of age and successfully completed Good Manners 1 as a minimum. Completion of Good Manners 2 or equivalent is recommended. Dog must know: Sit \& Sit-Stay, Down \& Down-Stay, Leave It, Watch Me, Hand Touch and Walk Politely on Leash.

All dogs must be people and dog friendly.


This four-week class focuses on skills dogs and handlers need to work well together when visiting people in facilities. Owners will gain understanding of animalassisted therapy, safety issues and the tools to become an effective therapy team.

SKILLS TAUGHT: Useful verbal cues and hand signals, heeling on both sides, cut/pass/flip, using a stool/mat, exposure to
healthcare equipment and distractions, and more.

Completion of this class will not include registration/certification as a therapy dog or team.
