Dogs must be at least 9 months old, non-reactive and have successfully completed Adolescent Dog/ Good Manners 1 or equivalent.

Dogs should have a solid sit, down, stay and walk nicely on a loose leash.

SKILLS TAUGHT: Sit, stay/wait, heeling on both sides, position side change pass/cut/flip.

STRATEGIES LEARNED: How to safely pass by strange dogs, cross streets, change direction, and head off trouble using games/tricks. How to politely greet people and children and how to appropriately potty your dog in public.
