

COMMUNITY WALKS

This is a 3-week class

This class will safely introduce & proof your dog to new situations, and different obstacles on the streets of downtown Napa.

First class meets at the Napa Valley Dog Training Club.



SKILLS: Heeling on both sides, cut / pass / flip and dog pottying on cue.

Field Trips will include walking politely up and down pedestrian stairs and ramps, plus riding comfortably in an elevator.

Prerequisites: Successful completion of Adolescent Dog &/or Good Manners 1 or equivalent class.
Dogs must be people and dog friendly and should be at least 1 year old.
Younger dogs can participate with Instructor's approval.

Dogs should consistently: "sit," "sit-stay," "down," "down-stay," "walk nicely on leash," "leave it," "watch me," and "touch" (the hand).
