### THINGS AT NVDTC ARE DIFFERENT NOW

The COVID-19 pandemic has brought about some changes at Napa Valley Dog Training Club. With classes going from six weeks to four weeks (due to COVID-19 factors), handling of first class orientations, shot records, and payments, all of which take up valuable time when puppy, adolescent, and good manners 1 classes first meet, made it necessary to come up with some new and different approaches.

- 1) Orientations will now be available online and viewing will be required by all puppy, adolescent, and good manners 1 students before attending their first class. Date videos will be viewable will be shown on our website
- 2) A copy of current shot records, as required by the Napa Valley Dog Training Club, MUST be sent to the club BEFORE attending your very first NVDTC lass. Shot records can be sent to the club via mail to P.O. Box 4097, Napa CA 94558 or sent via email to <a href="mailto:dogshots@nvdtc.org">dogshots@nvdtc.org</a>/.

Registration is now closed for session 3 classes and registration for session 4 classes will be announced on our website soon!



# NVDTC CHANGES RELATED TO COVID-19

In light of the COVID-19 situation, the NVDTC Board and trainers have come up with the following changes that will be put in place now that classes are resuming:

- 1. Orientation will no longer be done at the first class, as it will be via online-viewing (required for puppy, adolescent & GM1 classes). Puppy, adolescent & GM1 dogs can now come to their first class. Online orientation videos will be available for viewing before registration opens for puppy, adolescent, and good manners classes.
- 2. Classes will be 45 minutes in length to allow time between classes to disinfect everything.
- 3. All classes will be limited to six students.
- 4. Classes will be set up in four-week sessions at a cost of \$100.
- 5. Discounts will not be accepted at this time.
- 6. No drop-ins.
- 7. Payment required before classes start.
- 8. At this time, vouchers are limited to \$40 per class.
- 9. Students must agree to terms of our waiver which will include viewing of orientation for puppy, adolescent, and good manners 1 classes if taking such classes.
- 10. Students must agree to abide to COVID-19 restrictions and that they have no COVID-19 symptoms


