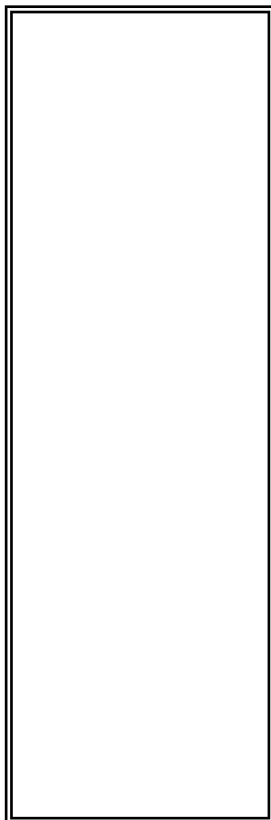

CLOSING DATE: Entries will be accepted until Wednesday, March 1, 2017, 12:00 noon, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

ENTRY FEE: \$125.00 (Includes \$.50 AKC Recording Fee and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee)

ELIGIBILITY: This test is for dogs that have earned an AKC TD or TDU title. It is open to all dogs that are registered with the AKC (AKC/PAL/ILP) and mixed breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the VST title; however, the Test Secretary will give priority to entries for dogs that do not hold a VST title. This test will be limited to 5 dogs. Entries will be accepted until the closing date, even though the limit has been reached. Test participants will be selected from all entries by a random drawing. When the limit is reached, the drawing will continue and an alternate list established in the order in which entries are drawn.

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate in this test with prior notice to the Test Secretary and compliance with all provisions of Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

DRAW FOR ENTRIES: A random draw for entries will be held on Wednesday, March 1, 2017, 1:00 PM at the Rincon Valley Library, Santa Rosa, CA.

ALTERNATES: An alternate list shall be maintained. It will consist of entries received by the closing date, but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for the limited entries.

NOTIFICATION: Entrants will be notified of the drawing results as soon as possible after the draw. If written notice is not received within a reasonable time, exhibitors and alternates should contact the Test Secretary.

REFUND POLICY: The entry fee will be refunded in the following cases: (1) If the entrant notifies the Test Secretary at least 48 hours prior to the test, and an alternate is available to run the track; or (2) for an entrant or alternate that is not given an opportunity to run a track.

The **HEALTH AND SAFETY** of the dogs, exhibitors, judges and spectators is of paramount importance. The test may be canceled or stopped before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

DRAW FOR RUNNING ORDER: All entrants must be at the Test Headquarters at 9:45 AM for track drawing. The test will begin when the first track has aged sufficiently. Entrants not present at the time of the draw will be marked absent by the Judges and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place. Please do not arrive prior to 8:45 AM.

TEST WORKER OPTION One (1) VST track will be reserved for a test worker who has earned required credit. If necessary, a random drawing may be held to determine which test worker is chosen. The remaining workers automatically will be included in the drawing with all other tracking entries received.

TEST HEADQUARTERS: The Lakeside Grill at Vintner's Golf Club, 7901 Solano Avenue, Yountville, CA 94599. From Napa, take Hwy 29 North to the town of Yountville. Take the Veteran's Home exit, go under the freeway, and make the first left onto Solano Avenue. The clubhouse is ahead, on the right. Park at the south end of the parking lot near the fire station.

AWARDS: Each passing team will receive an acrylic frame with a map of their track and a photo of them with the Judges.

LUNCHEON: Following the test there will be a no-host lunch at the Lakeside Grill, Vintner's Golf Club, 7901 Solano Avenue, Yountville, CA.

PRACTICING: Practicing on the test site is allowed up to 3 days prior to the test. Dogs **MUST** be kept on leash at ALL times. Your cooperation in cleaning up after your dogs will be greatly appreciated.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold AKC, the event giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or event secretary, and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., Over 13 in. But not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth) Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions is Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
