To this extent, we will be following the Center of Disease Control (CDC) and local health department guidelines with regard to social distancing practices in order to reduce the spread of Novel Coronavirus, or COVID-19. This will require our staff, instructors, workers, and volunteers to maintain six (6) feet of distance between ourselves and you, the client, as much as possible. We will also be requiring this same procedure for client-to-client contact in order to limit the exposure to all individuals.

We will require all individuals (staff, instructors, volunteers, clients, and visitors) to utilize either surgical masks or improvised masks such as scarves, bandanas, and handkerchiefs to reduce the risk of exposure to yourself and others. Students and visitors are required to provide their own masks.

It is also required of everyone to either wash or sanitize their hands when entering the Napa Valley Dog Training facility and after using the restroom, sneezing, and coughing.
