CHANGES RELATED TO COVID-19

In light of the COVID-19 situation, the NVDTC Board and trainers have come up with the following changes that will be put in place now that classes are resuming:

- 1. Orientation will no longer be done at the first class, as it will be via online-viewing (required for puppy, adolescent & GM1 classes). Puppy, adolescent & GM1 dogs can now come to their first class. Online orientation videos will be available for viewing before registration opens for puppy, adolescent, and good manners classes.**
- 2. Classes will be 45 minutes in length to allow time between classes to disinfect everything.**
- 3. All classes will be limited to six students.**
- 4. Classes will be set up in four-week sessions at a cost of \$100.**
- 5. Discounts will not be accepted at this time.**
- 6. No drop-ins.**
- 7. Payment required before classes start.**
- 8. At this time, vouchers are limited to \$40 per class.**
- 9. Students must agree to terms of our waiver which will include viewing of orientation for puppy, adolescent, and good manners 1 classes if taking such classes.**
- 10. Students must agree to abide to COVID-19 restrictions and that they have no COVID-19 symptoms.**
